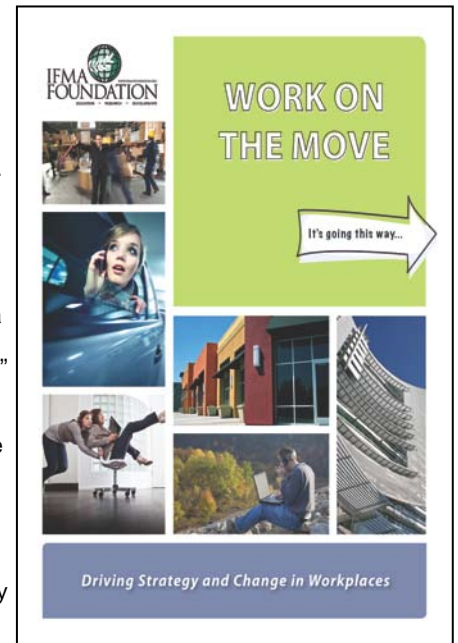


**IFMA's WORLD WORKPLACE 2011**

Produced by the IFMA Foundation and edited by facility manager and workplace pioneer Diane Coles, the book ***Work on the Move - Driving Strategy and Change in Workplaces***, is the collaborative effort of international workplace experts. Filled with case studies from around the globe, the book addresses these challenges and provides insights into how facility professionals can participate in the workplace revolution.

The work environment is changing. New technologies are making workers more mobile and accessible than ever, while more companies are conducting operations globally. The result is more work/life integration – an employee might get into work late because of a play at their child’s school, but they were on a conference call with China until midnight the night before. Social trends are changing work as well. The current “sandwich” generation is taking care of both children and elderly parents, requiring more flexibility from their employers. Building owners are driven to build and operate more efficient, sustainable office spaces. Traditional workspaces no longer fit the collaborative nature of today’s work.

So do we still need physical workspaces? Where is the traditional space plan headed? How will the transformation change the field of facility management? Already today’s facility managers must not only manage a global portfolio of facilities, but also address the challenges of space needs for remote collaboration and teamwork. The impact of flexible work on interior design and the ability to work “anywhere,” requires facility managers to think differently and create spaces that provide a multitude of work areas to meet the varied demands of this new way of working. What other changes are on the horizon, and how should facility managers respond?
