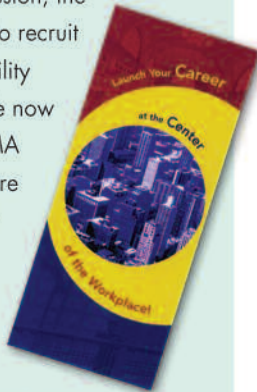




New IFMA Foundation Brochure for the Next Generation of Facility Managers
